Fabric BB See instructions to cut (11) wedge \#2.
Fabric CC $\quad$ See instructions to cut (11) wedge \#1.
Fabric DD See instructions to cut (11) wedge \#1.
Fabric EE Cut (3) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 561 / 2 "$ strips.
Cut (3) $11 / 2$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1^{1 / 2 "} \times 501 / 2 "$ strips.
See instructions to cut (11) centers.
Fabric FF $\operatorname{Cut}(11) 81 / 2$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (42) $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
Cut (3) 2 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " $\times 581 / 2 "$ strips.
Cut (3) 2 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " $\times 53^{1 / 2 "}$ " strips.

Backing Cut (2) 61 " $\times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 61" x 69" backing.

Fusible web

## Making the Quilt

1. Block Assembly

Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about $1 / 8$ " outside the drawn lines.
2. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
3. Refer to the Diagram 1 to arrange and press (4) wedge \#1 and (4) wedge \#2 onto (1) $81 / 2$ " Fabric FF square. Make sure to center the wedges on the background leaving $1 / 4$ " clear around the outside edge for the seam allowance. Arrange and press (1) Fabric I Center onto the center of the Fabric FF square.
4. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make (1) Block One square.
5. Repeat Steps 3-4 to make (12) Block One squares total.

6. Repeat Steps 3-4 and refer to Diagrams 2-4 for fabric identification and location to make (10) Block Two squares, (9) Block Three squares and (11) Block Four squares.

## Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)
7. Sew (6) assorted blocks together to make (1) row. Repeat to make (7) rows total. Note: Pay attention to the orientation of the blocks.
8. Sew the (7) rows together to make the Center Block.
9. Sew (1) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 561 / 2 "$ Fabric EE strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1^{1 / 2 "} \times 50^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric EE strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
10. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 581 / 2 "$ Fabric FF strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x $531 / 2 "$ Fabric FF strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

## Finishing the Quilt

11. Layer and quilt as desired.
12. Sew the (6) Fabric $F$ binding strips together, end to end with a 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
13. Bind as desired.
