5 Black From each: Binding Cut (43) squares 2½" Cut (8) strips 2½" x WOF for binding

Backing

18 Brights From each:


Cut (2) lengths 40" x 80", pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

Cut (2) squares 8½" Cut (4) rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ "

Cut (4) rectangles 2½" x 8½"

Making the Quilt

- 1. Fussy-cut directional prints if you want the printed design to stay upright in the block. Otherwise, cut the rectangles crosswise or lengthwise with no regard to the print direction.
- 2. A fast stitch-and-flip technique is used to add the black patches to the ends of rectangles. Draw a diagonal line on the back of 21/2" black squares. Position a marked square as shown on one end of each 10½" bright rectangle (Diagram 1), noting direction of the stitching line. Stitch on the marked diagonal line. Cut away the excess fabric. Press the corner up. Repeat this step on the end of each 81/2" rectangle (Diagram 2), noting that the diagonal stitching line is in a different orientation. Repeat these steps for each block.



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
3. Arrange the pieced rectangles, 2 black 2½" squares, and the 8½" bright square in 3 horizontal rows as shown in the Block diagram. Join the patches into rows, and then join the rows to make a block. Make 36 blocks, each block with a different combination of 1 black print and 1 bright print.



4. Referring to the Quilt Diagram, arrange blocks in 6 rows of 6 blocks each, rotating every other block so the black patches form stars as shown. When you are satisfied with the design, join the blocks in rows, and then join the rows.

Finishing the Quilt

5. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around patches. Quilt around the printed motifs. Bind to finish the quilt.
