Quilt finishes 48" x 551/2"

Muted pastels make this soothing quilt, just right for napping in a hammock. The floral prints blend beautifully with the butterfly prints, and a stripe with leaves is the finishing touch.

Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances. A fat $\frac{1}{4}$ is an 18" x 20"-22" cut. The mitered borders include extra length for insurance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Fabric A

Fussy-cut (2) side borders 4" x 50", cut lengthwise Fussy-cut (2) t/b borders 4" x 42½", cut lengthwise

Fabric B

Fussy-cut (2) side borders 3½" x 56", cut lengthwise Fussy-cut (2) t/b borders 3½" x 48½", cut lengthwise

Fabric C

Cut (10) strips 11/2" x WOF, pieced to make the following:

- (2) outer side borders 1½" x 58"
- (2) outer t/b borders $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $50\frac{1}{2}$ "
- (2) inner side borders $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 43"
- (2) inner t/b borders $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $35\frac{1}{2}$ "
- Cut (6) strips 2½" x WOF for binding

Fabric D

Cut all strips crosswise:

Cut (2) side borders 11/2" x 41"

Cut (2) t/b borders 11/2" x 331/2"

Cut (4) sashes 11/2" x 291/2"

Cut (20) sashes $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7"

5 Prints From each:

Cut (4-6) rectangles $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7" (25 total)

Backing

Cut (2) panels $32'' \times 56''$, pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides


Making the Quilt

- 1. Look at the quilt photograph to choose where to cut Fabric A border strips. Fussy-cut the 4 Fabric A borders lengthwise from the same part of the print. Repeat this step for Fabric B border strips, noting the placement of the large bees.
- 2. Referring to the Quilt Diagram, arrange the 25 print rectangles in any order you desire. Join 5 rectangles alternately with 4 short Fabric D sashes to make a horizontal row. Make 5 rows. Sew rows together alternately with the 29½"-long Fabric D sashes.
- 3. Matching centers, join 5 border strips in the order shown to make a pieced border for each side of the quilt. Sew the borders to the quilt, starting and stopping stitching 1/4" from the quilt's raw edge.

 Miter the corners and trim the excess.

Finishing the Quilt

4. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around borders and block patches. Quilt around the printed motifs in the rectangles and borders. Bind to finish the quilt.
