Notes:

- Make sure to visit <u>http://www.makoweruk.com/projects/</u> to ensure you are working from the most up-to-date version of the pattern
- Makower UK provides the written instructions only to accompany the named collection. Retailers are free to
 use these free instructions to provide a fabric kit. Accurate cutting of fabric is down to the individual retailer
 and any fabric supply enquires should be directed to point of purchase
- Read the pattern in full before starting
- 1/4" seams are used throughout except where stated otherwise
- Press after each seam, pressing seams open or to one side as preferred
- WOF width of fabric a strip of fabric cut from selvedge to selvedge

Making the quilt

- 1. Cut the fabrics as shown in the fabric requirements table.
- 2. For each of the nine dinosaurs, trace the main body onto the back of the fusible web then trace the additional dinosaur pieces onto a separate piece of fusible web. Cut out each shape roughly.

NB: some of the dinosaurs face left and some face right so make sure to cut out the right number of each facing in each direction – remember that you will be tracing the mirror image onto the back of the fusible web so, for a right facing dinosaur, trace a left facing dinosaur onto the back of the fusible web.

- 3. Fuse the traced bodies to the back of the print dinosaur fabrics and the additional dinosaur pieces to the back of the linea and linen texture fabrics. Cut out each piece and remove paper from the back.
- 4. Fuse the dinosaur bodies and then the additional pieces to the cream solid 14 ½" squares.
- 5. Secure in place using a blanket, straight, zigzag or other decorative stitch.
- 6. Sew all the print, linea and linen textures 2 ½" squares into four patches, randomly mixing up the colours. You will make forty-eight four-patches and will have a number of 2 ½" squares left over.
- 7. Sew twelve vertical strips with a four patch on the top and bottom of a portrait style 2536 Q or B $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle.
- 8. Sew twelve horizontal strips with a four patch on each end of a landscape style 2536 Q or B 4 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangle.
- 9. Sew the seven rows of the quilt together following the layout in the main quilt image and as follows:
 - Rows 1, 3, 5 and 7 contain four 2537 Q or B squares and three horizontal four-patch strips.
 - Rows 2, 4, and 6 contain four vertical four patch strips and three dinosaurs.
- 10. Sew the seven rows together to finish the quilt top.

Finishing the quilt

- 1. Sew the binding strips end to end using diagonal or straight seams as preferred and press wrong sides together along the length to make a double fold binding.
- 2. Make a quilt sandwich for each item, basting together the back, the wadding and the top.
- 3. Quilt as desired then trim square, removing excess wadding and backing.
- 4. Bind, taking care to mitre the corners.
