

Quilt finishes 72" x 80 " 72 Blocks: 8" x 8"

A rainbow of stars made with space age prints is arranged in an unusual diagonal setting. The stars wink in and out, some dark and bold, others softly muted. The fun comes with arranging the stars following the quilt diagram or with your own design sensibilities. The Flying Geese Units are made with an easy no-fail method.

Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include ¼" seam allowances. A fat ¼ is an 18" x 20"-22" cut. Borders are cut the exact lengths required plus ¼" seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Yardage is generous so feel free to cut fewer or more stars of your favorite fabrics.

Cutting for ONE block:

Fabric A	Cut (4) rectangles 21/2" x 41/2"
	Cut (4) squares 2½"

- Fat ¼ print
 Cut (1) square 4½"

 Cut (8) squares 2½"
- Fabric A
 Cut (4) borders 4½" x 72½"

 Cut (288) rectangles 2½" x 4½"


 Cut (288) squares 2½"
- **9 Fat ¹/4s** From each: (Makes 4 stars each) Cut (4) rectangles 2¹/₂" x 4¹/₂" Cut (32) squares 2¹/₂"
- **2 Fat ¹/4s** From each: (Makes 3 stars each) Cut (3) rectangles 2¹/₂" x 4¹/₂" Cut (24) squares 2¹/₂"
- **12 Fat ¹/4s** From each: (Makes 2 stars each) Cut (2) rectangles 2¹/₂" x 4¹/₂" Cut (16) squares 2¹/₂"
- **6 Fat ¹/4s** From each: (Makes 1 star each) Cut (1) rectangle 2¹/₂" x 4¹/₂" Cut (8) squares 2¹/₂"
- **Binding** Cut (8) strips 2¹/₂" x WOF for binding
- **Backing** Cut (2) panels 40" x 88", pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides


Making the Quilt

 The blocks are made with quick stitch-and-flip Flying Geese Units. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each print 2¹/₂" square. Place a marked square on one end of a Fabric A 2¹/₂" x 4¹/₂" rectangle, right sides together. Sew on the marked line; trim away and discard excess fabric (Diagram 1). Press open. Repeat this process on the opposite end of the rectangle (Diagram 2) to make a Flying Geese Unit. Make 4 for each block.

- 2. Referring to the Block diagram, arrange 4 Flying Geese Units, the center 4½" square, and 4 Fabric A 2½" squares in the order shown. Be careful to rotate the Flying Geese to form the star. Join the parts into rows, and then join the rows.
- **3.** Using the Quilt Diagram for reference, position the stars in 9 horizontal rows of 8 blocks each. Stand back to be sure that the prints are arranged as you wish. Looking through a camera or the wrong end of binoculars may help you adjust the colors. Once you are satisfied with the arrangement, join the blocks and patches in rows, and then join the rows.





4. Sew the Fabric A borders to the sides, and then to the top and bottom.




5. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around borders and block patches. Quilt around the printed motifs in the blocks. Or, quilt an overall pattern. Bind to finish the quilt.
