## Making the Quilt

Note: Pay attention to the orientation of the units while assembling the various components.

## 1. Block Assembly

Place (1) $37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric Q square on top of (1) $37 / 8^{7 \prime}$ Fabric AA square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Diagram 1). Sew $1 / 4$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 2) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure $3^{1 / 2 "}$ square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Diagram 3). Repeat to make (16) Unit 1 squares total.

2. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Diagrams 4-12 for fabric identification and placement to make (16) Unit 2 squares and (8) of each square, Units 3 through Units 10.

3. Place (1) $21 / 2$ " Fabric A square on the bottom right corner of (1) $31 / 2$ " Fabric AA square, right sides together (Diagram 13). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 13). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4$ " away from the sewn seam to make (1) Unit 11 square (Diagram 14). Repeat to make (4) Unit 11 squares total.

Sew across the diagonal of the small square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Diagram 48). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 49). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4$ " away from the sewn seam.
10. Follow Diagram 50 for the seam direction to add a $21 / 2$ " Fabric A square to the lower left corner of the $31 / 4 " \times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric A strip to make (1) Unit 45 strip (Diagram 51).
11. Repeat Steps $9-10$ to make (4) Unit 45 strips total.

19. Sew together (1) $1^{1 / 2 "} \times 181 / 2 "$ Fabric AA strip,
(1) Block Four square, (1) $11 / 2$ " $\times 181 / 2$ " Fabric AA strip,
(1) Block Five square, (1) $11 / 2 " \times 181 / 2 "$ Fabric AA strip,
(1) Block Six square and (1) $11 / 2 " \times 181 / 2 "$ Fabric AA strip, in that order from left to right, to make Row Two.

21. Sew together (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 181 / 2$ " Fabric AA strip, (1) Block Ten square, (1) $11 / 2 " \times 181 / 2 "$ Fabric AA strip, (1) Block Eleven square, (1) $11 / 2 " \times 181 / 2 "$ Fabric AA strip, (1) Block Twelve square and (1) $11 / 2 " \times 181 / 2 "$ Fabric AA strip, in that order from left to right, to make Row Four.
22. Sew together the (5) Block Thirteen strips and (4) pieced rows in numerical order, lengthwise and alternating them from top to bottom, to make the Center Block.
23. Sew (1) $31 / 2 " x 771 / 2 "$ Fabric AA strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $31 / 2$ " x $641 / 2 "$ Fabric AA strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

## Finishing the Quilt

24. Layer and quilt as desired.
25. Sew the (8) Fabric L binding strips together, end to end with a 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
26. Bind as desired.
