Whether you are a gardener or just an admirer of flowers, the floral prints in this collection are sure to delight you. The novelty print squares are set together with simple pieced blocks made of only three patches each. The white sashes and black frames around each garden scene add a bold design element to the tranquil quilt.

#### **Cutting Directions**

**Note:** Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include ¼" seam allowances. A fat ¼ is a 9" x 20"-22" cut of fabric. Borders are cut the exact lengths required plus ¼" seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

**Fabric A** Fussy-cut (8) squares  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $9\frac{1}{2}$ "

- Fabric B Cut (6) strips 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF for binding
- Fabric CCut (2) borders 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 58<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>", cut lengthwiseCut (2) borders 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 46<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>", cut lengthwise
- Fabric DCut (5) sashes  $2^{1}/2'' \ge 46^{1}/2''$ , cut lengthwise<br/>Cut (20) sashes  $2^{1}/2'' \ge 9^{1}/2''$
- **8 Fat <sup>1</sup>%'s** From each: Cut (1) rectangle 5" x 9<sup>1</sup>/2" Cut (1) rectangle 5" x 6<sup>1</sup>/2" Cut (1) rectangle 5" x 3<sup>1</sup>/2"
- **Backing** Cut (2) panels 34" x 66", pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

#### **Making and Assembling the Quilt**

- **1.** Cut the Fabric A squares carefully, including a <sup>1</sup>/4" seam allowance around the 9" centers.
- Referring to the Block Diagram, arrange and join one of each size rectangle (cut from the fat ¼ yard fabrics) to make a pieced block. Note the arrangement of the rectangles differs in the blocks. Refer to the quilt photograph for fabric selection, or make

your own combination of prints. As long as the 3 rectangles are cut from 3 different fabrics, your blocks will be successful. Make 8 blocks total.

- Referring to the Quilt Diagram, arrange 2 Fabric A squares and 2 pieced blocks in a horizontal row. Turn the pieced blocks as you wish. Sew the blocks with 5 Fabric D short sashes to make a block row. Make 4 rows, alternating the printed squares and blocks in the order shown.
- 4. Sew the block rows between 5 long sashes.
- 5. Sew the shorter border strips to the sides of the quilt. Sew the longer strips to the top and bottom.

#### **Finishing the Quilt**

**6.** Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around borders and block patches. Quilt around the motifs in the printed squares, blocks, and outer border. Bind to finish the quilt.
