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Fabric Requirements

| 2347 S (binding) | $50 \mathrm{cms} / 1 / 2$ yard | Six $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips |

| 2348 Q (backing) | $3.5 \mathrm{~m} / 3 \mathrm{3} / 4$ yards | Two equal lengths |

| 2349 B | $30 \mathrm{~cm} / 12$ " | Six $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips cut into eight $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}, 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and $10 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ lengths |
| 2349 Q | FQ | Four $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares |
| 2349 Y | $40 \mathrm{~cm} / 15$ " | Eight $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips cut into twelve $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}, 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and $101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ lengths |
| 2350 Q | 40cm / 15" | Eight $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips cut into twelve $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}, 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and $101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ lengths |
| 23521 Panel | One panel $60 \mathrm{cms} / 24$ " | Cut eight $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares from the panel and one $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip from the vertical cat heads image for the centre block of the quilt |
| 2000 W02 (BKG) | $1.75 \mathrm{~m} / 2 \mathrm{yds}$ | Twenty-five $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips cut into $40021 / 2$ " squares One 2" WOF strip cut into two 2 " x $61 / 2 "$ strips |

## Notes:

- Make sure to visit http://www.makoweruk.com/projects/ to ensure you are working from the most up-to-date version of the pattern
- Read the pattern in full before starting
- $1 / 4$ " seams are used throughout except where stated otherwise
- Press after each seam, pressing seams open or to one side as preferred
- WOF - width of fabric - a strip of fabric cut from selvedge to selvedge
- WOFQ - a strip of fabric cut from selvedge to centre cut on a FQ
- BKG - background


## Making the Quilt Top

1. Sew the two BKG 2 " $\times 61 / 2$ " strips to either side of the vertical strip of three cat heads taken from the panel.
2. Draw a diagonal line on the back of all of the BKG $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
3. Place four of these squares right sides together with four corners of one of the $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ print or panel squares or the piece made at 1 above and sew along the diagonal lines (fig 1). Trim away excess fabric $1 / 4 "$ beyond the seam line (fig 2 ) and press over (fig 3 ).

4. Sew $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strips to either side of that square and press over. Sew two more to the top and bottom and press over (fig 4).
5. Add BKG triangles to the four corners of this piece as you did at step 3 (fig 5).
6. Continue to add rounds of sashing strips - $81 / 2$ " then $10 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " and BKG triangles in the same way to make each block. (fig 6). Take care to follow the fabric placement of the sashing strips as shown in the main quilt image.

7. Sew the blocks into five rows of five then sew those rows together to finish the quilt top.

## Finishing the quilt

1. Sew the binding strips end to end using diagonal or straight seams as preferred and press wrong sides together along the length to make a double fold binding.
2. Sew the two pieces of backing fabric together. Make a quilt sandwich, basting together the back, the wadding and the top.
3. Quilt as desired then trim square, removing excess wadding and backing. We quilted a diagonal cross hatch of wavy lines approx. $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " using a cream 40wt Aurifil thread on the front and back.
4. Bind, taking care to mitre the corners.
