# Lost in Space Quilt

Quilt finishes 55' x 75'
Send your little astronaut into space with this adorable comforter. The pieced borders frame either a daytime or nighttime panel. The quilt presents a fun opportunity to teach color names with the bright fabrics.

## Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowances. A fat $1 / 4$ is an $18^{\prime \prime} \times 22^{\prime \prime}$ cut. Borders are cut the exact lengths required plus $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately $44^{\prime \prime}$ wide).

## Fabric A

Fussy-cut (1) panel $23^{1 / 2 \prime 2} \times 43{ }^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}$ cut crosswise
(Read Step 1 before cutting.)

## Fabric B

Cut (6) strips $5^{1 / 2 \prime} \times$ WOF, pieced to make the following:
(2) side borders $5^{1 / 2^{\prime \prime}} \times 65^{1 / 2^{\prime \prime}}$
(2) top/bottom borders $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 45^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}$

## Fabric C

Cut (4) strips $1^{1 / 2 \prime} \times$ WOF, pieced to make the following:
(2) side borders $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 431 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (Read Step 1 before cutting.)
(2) $\mathrm{t} / \mathrm{b}$ borders $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 251 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

Cut (5) squares $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Fabric D Cut (4) squares $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Fabric E Cut (4) squares $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Fabric F Cut (4) squares $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ for outer border corners
7 Solids From each:
Cut (5) squares $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
6 Prints From each:
Cut (4) squares $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Binding

Cut (7) strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF for binding

## Backing

Cut (2) panels $41^{\prime \prime} \times 61^{\prime \prime}$, pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

## Making the Quilt

1. Fussy-cut the panel. If it measures smaller than $231 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 43^{1 / 2^{\prime \prime}}$, cut Fabric $C$ borders wider ( $2^{\prime \prime}-2^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}}$ ).
2. Sew Fabric C borders to the panel. If needed, trim the unit to $25^{1 / 2^{\prime \prime}} \times 45^{1 / 2^{\prime \prime}}$, keeping the Fabric C borders equal on all sides.
3. Referring to the Quilt Diagram, position the print squares all around the quilt. Feel free to arrange them in any order you wish. Once you are satisfied with the arrangement, join 9 squares to make a side border. Repeat for the other side. Join 7 squares to make the top border. Repeat for the bottom. Sew borders to the quilt.
4. Likewise, position the solid squares around the quilt. Join 11 squares to make each side border. Sew 9 squares to make the top and bottom borders. Sew borders to the quilt.
5. Join long Fabric B borders to the sides. Sew Fabric F squares to ends of shorter borders, and sew to the top and bottom.

## Finishing the Quilt

6. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around borders and block patches. Quilt around the printed motifs in the blocks and outer border. Bind to finish the quilt.
