


Quilt finishes 84" x 100"

Prints are stitched in rainbow order to make this eye-popping color wheel that will look smashing covering a queen-size bed or hanging in a special spot in your home. The use of a specialty ruler makes the construction of the circle of wedges easy enough for anyone to construct.

Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Fabric A

Cut (10) strips 2½" x WOF for binding
Cut (2) panels 101" x WOF for background

Fabric B

Cut (1) 10-degree wedge 25" long
Fussy-cut (1) 9½" diameter circle

35 Prints

From each:
Cut (1) 10-degree wedge 25" long

Backing

Cut (3) panels 37" x 90", pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

Also needed: 10-degree wedge 25" ruler (from Sew Easy)

Making the Quilt

1. Refer to the instructions that come with the 10-degree wedge ruler to cut 1 wedge from Fabric B and 1 wedge from each of the 35 prints. Referring to the quilt photograph and Quilt Diagram, arrange the wedges in a color wheel as shown. Join the wedges side by side to form the circle. Press the seam allowances in one direction. Press under the outer edge ¼" for traditional appliqué, or leave the edge raw if you wish. Read Step 3 to finish the edges.
2. Prepare the 9½" circle for appliqué. We suggest that you press under the outer edge and baste. Position the circle in the center of the color wheel and stitch in place.
3. Join the Fabric A panels side by side to make the background. Center the pieced color wheel on the background. Stitch the edge as you wish, either with hidden appliqué stitches or a decorative stitch.

Finishing the Quilt

4. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around the circles and quilt along the seams of the wedges. Quilt the background as you wish. One option is to quilt concentric circles 2"-3" apart that radiate out from the circle. Bind to finish the quilt.
