## Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42 " wide).

Backing Cut (2) 65 " $\times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 65 " $\times 80$ " backing.

## Making the Quilt

1. Block Assembly

Sew (1) Fabric A-Template 1 (T1) triangle to (1)
Fabric R-Template 2 (T2) triangle along the long edges to make (1) Unit 1 triangle (Diagram 1). Repeat to make (24) Unit 1 triangles total.

2. Repeat Step 1 and follow Diagrams $2-17$ for fabric identification and placement to make the indicated number of units for Unit 2 through Unit 17.

## Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)
3. Lay out (1) Fabric R-T1 triangle, (21) assorted units and (1) Fabric R-T2 triangle as shown in the Quilt Layout for Row 1. Pay attention to the unit orientations. Sew the units together to make Row 1.
4. Repeat Step 3 to make Row 3, Row 5, Row 7, Row 9, Row 11, Row 13, and Row 15. Pay attention to the unit orientations.
5. Lay out (1) Fabric R-T2 triangle, (21) assorted units and (1) Fabric R-T1 triangle as shown in Quilt Layout for Row 2. Pay attention to the unit orientations. Sew the units together to make Row 2.
6. Repeat Step 5 to make Row 4, Row 6, Row 8, Row 10, Row 12, Row 14 and Row 16. Pay attention to the unit orientations.
7. Sew the (16) Rows together, in numerical order, to make the quilt top.

## Finishing the Quilt

8. Layer and quilt as desired.
9. Sew the (7) Fabric $S$ binding strips together, end to end with a 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
10. Bind as desired.
