## Cutting Directions

## Note: Read assembly directions before cutting

patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42 " wide).

## Making the Quilt

1. Block Assembly

Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 20$ " Fabric C strip to the left side of (1) $21 / 2$ " $\times 20$ " Fabric B strip lengthwise to make
(1) Strip Set (Diagram 1). Repeat to make (17) Strip Sets total.
2. Cut (6) $21 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ strips from each Strip Set to make (102) Unit 1 strips (Diagram 2).

3. Sew together (21) Unit 1 strips lengthwise to make
(1) Block One strip (Diagram 3). Repeat to make
(4) Block One strips total.
4. Sew together (2) Unit 1 strips, (1) $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A strip, (1) Unit 1 strip, (1) $61 / 2 " \times 101 / 2 "$ Fabric A strip, (1) Unit 1 strip, (1) $61 / 2 " \times 101 / 2$ " Fabric A strip and (2) Unit 1 strips, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make
(1) Block Two strip
(Diagram 4). Repeat to make (3) Block Two strips total.

5. Sew together the (4) Block One strips and (3) Block Two strips, lengthwise and alternating them from left to right, to make the $421 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 421 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Center Block.

## Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)
6. Center (1) $61 / 2 " \times 58 "$ Fabric D strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a $1 / 4 "$ from the top edge of the block and stop a $1 / 4$ " from the bottom edge. DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS. Repeat with the opposite side.
7. Repeat Step 6 to sew (1) $61 / 2 " \times 58$ " strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start $1 / 4 "$ away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides.
8. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Diagram 6), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to
 make the quilt top.

## Finishing the Quilt

9. Layer and quilt as desired.
10. Sew the (6) binding strips together, end to end with a 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in halflengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
11. Bind as desired.
