

## **Cutting Directions**

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus ¼" seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Fabric A	Cut (2) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (5) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
Fabric B	Cut (2) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (5) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
Fabric C	Cut (2) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (5) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
Fabric D	Cut (2) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the

	strips into (16) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
Fabric F	Cut (6) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the

Backing Cut (2) 57" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 57" x 57" back.



### **Making the Quilt**


#### 1. Block Assembly

1. Place (1)  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip on the right side of (1)  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F square, aligning the top edges of each piece. Sew the two pieces together starting at the top and stopping halfway down the Fabric F square (Diagram 1).

**2.** Sew (1)  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top of the sewn unit (Diagram 2).



**3.** Sew (1)  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A strip to the left of the sewn unit (Diagram 3).



# **Masterpiece**

**4.** Sew (1) 5 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric D strip to the bottom of the sewn unit (Diagram 4).



- 5. Complete the seam started in Step 1 to complete (1) Block One square (Diagram 5).
- **6.** Repeat Steps 1-5 to make (5) Block One squares total.




7. Repeat Steps 1-5 with (4) 5 ½" Fabric F squares and (16) 5 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric E strips mixing the colors of the strips as desired to make (4) Block Two squares total (Diagram 6).





**10.** Sew together (4) 1 ½" x 49 ½" Fabric F strips and the three Rows, alternating them, to make the quilt top. Make sure to sew the rows in numerical order.

## Finishing the Quilt

- 11. Layer and quilt as desired.
- **12.** Sew the (5) Fabric F binding strips together, end to end with a 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 13. Bind as desired.



Quilt Layout


#### **Quilt Top Assembly**

#### (Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)

- 8. Sew together (4)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $15\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strips, (2) Block One squares and (1) Block Two square to make Row 1. Repeat to make Row 3.
- **9.** Sew together (4) 1 ½" x 15 ½" Fabric F strips, (2) Block Two squares and (1) Block One square to make Row 2.
