## Plain and Simple Quilt

Introducing Andover Fabrics new collection: PLAIN AND SIMPLE by Andover Fabrics Quilt designed by Janet Houts

Quilt finishes 60" x 78"

Easy does it with this appealing quilt that keeps the eye guessing: Where is the block? There are only 12 of them, each 18" square, and with the large patches that are simple to piece, you will be napping under this one in no time at all.

### **Cutting Directions**

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" seam allowances. A fat 1/8 is a 9" x 20"-22" cut of fabric. Borders are cut the exact lengths required plus 1/4" seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

#### **Fabric** A

Cut (2) side borders 2½" x 74½", cut crosswise Cut (2) top/bottom borders 2½" x 60½"

#### **Fabric B**

Cut (2) side borders 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 72<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>", cut crosswise Cut (2) top/bottom borders 11/2" x 561/2"

#### **Fabric** C

Cut (24) squares 9%", cut in half diagonally to make 48 half-square triangles

#### **Fabric D**

Cut (72) squares 3%", cut in half diagonally to make 144 half-square triangles

- D half-square triangles with 6 different print triangles to make 3 rows as shown. Stand back to be certain the placement is correct. Join the triangles into rows, and then join the rows to make half the unit. Sew a Fabric C triangle to the long edge. Make 4 quarter blocks, each with different prints. Finally, join the 4 quarter blocks to make a block, turning the units to form the "pinwheel" design. Make 12 blocks.
- Making the Quilt 1. Referring to the Quarter Block diagram, join 3 Fabric

#### **36 Prints** From each:


Cut (4) squares 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>8</sub>", cut in half diagonally to make 8 half-square triangles. You need 288 total triangles.


#### Binding

Cut (7) strips 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF for binding

#### **Backing**

Cut (2) lengths 35" x 88", pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides






Block - Make 12

- 2. Referring to the Quilt Assembly, arrange the blocks into 4 rows of 3 blocks each, pressing seam allowances in opposite directions in alternating rows. Join the rows. Press seam allowances in one direction or open.
- 3. Sew Fabric B borders to the sides, and then to the top and bottom. Repeat this step to add Fabric A borders.

Finishing the Quilt4. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around borders and patches. Quilt the large triangles as you wish. Bind to finish the quilt.
