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Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus ¼" seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Fabric A	Fussy cut (1) 23 " x $42\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle,
	centered on the panel.

Fabric B	Cut (2) 4" x 28" WOF strips.
	Cut (2) 3" x 42 ½" WOF strips, piece
	as needed.
	Cut (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut
	the strip into (48) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ "
	strips.

Cut (3) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strip into (48) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Cut (3) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the

strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 48 ½" strips.

Cut (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 44 ½" strips.

Fabric C	Cut (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut
	the strip into (4) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Fabric D Cut (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (32) 2 ½" squares. Cut (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 50 ½" strips.

Cut (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 47 ½" strips.

Cut (7) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

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Fabric E	Cut (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip

	into (40) 2 ½" squares.

Fabric G	Cut (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip
	into (3) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Fabric H	Cut (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips
	into (24) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.



Making the Quilt

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Block Assembly

Sew (1) 3" x 42 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the 23" x 42 1/2" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 4" x 28" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Diagram 1). Trim the block to measure 26 ½" x 48 ½".



Place (1) 2 ½" Fabric D square on the left side of (1) 2 ½" x 4½" Fabric B strip, right sides together (Diagram 2). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance (Diagram 3).

- **3.** Place another 2 ½" Fabric D square on the right side of the 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric B strip, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Diagram 4). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Diagram 5).
- Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (16) Unit 1 strips.



5. Repeat Steps 2-3 and refer to Diagrams 6-7 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (20) Unit 2 strips and (12) Unit 3 strips.




6. Sew (1) 2 ½" Fabric B square to each end of (1) Unit 1 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to each side of (1) 4 1/2" Fabric C square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together lengthwise to make (1) 8 ½" Block One square (Diagram 8). Repeat to make (4) Block One squares total.



Repeat Step 6 and refer to Diagrams 9-10 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (5) Block Two squares and (3) Block Three squares.







- **8.** Follow Diagram 11 and sew together (1) Block One, (1) Block Two, (1) Block Three, (1) Block Two (1) Block One and (1) Block Two, in that order from top to bottom, to make the Left Side Border.
- 9. Follow Diagram 12 and sew together (1) Block Three, (1) Block One, (1) Block Two, (1) Block One (1) Block Two and (1) Block Three, in that order from top to bottom, to make the Right Side Border.

Finishing the Quilt

- 14. Layer and quilt as desired.
- **15.** Sew the (7) Fabric D binding strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 16. Bind as desired.



Quilt Layout


Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)

- 10. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.
- **11.** Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 44 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 12. Sew (1) 2" x 50 1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 47 1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- **13.** Sew (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x 53 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 6 ½" x 59 ½" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

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
