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# Notion to Sew Quilt 

Introducing Andover Fabrics new collection: SEW HAPPY by Kim Schaefer Quilt designed by Kim Schaefer
10)

Quilt finishes 56" x 72'

What a fun way to pay tribute to one's love of sewing. The center panel is chock-full of amusing pincushions, pins and needles and thread, and many of the implements that quilters use for their craft. The dark panel and the light panel offer two slight variations.

## Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowances. Borders are cut the exact lengths required plus $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide).

## Fabric A

Fussy-cut the panel $241 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
(Read Step 1 before cutting)

## Fabric B

Cut (6) strips $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF, pieced to make the following:
(2) side borders $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 641 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
(2) top/bottom borders $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 48^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}$

## Fabric C

Cut (4) squares $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Fabric D

Cut (4) squares $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Fabric E

Cut (5) strips $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF, pieced to make the following:
(2) side borders $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 481 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
(2) top/bottom borders $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 321 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Fabric F

Cut (6) strips $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF, pieced to make the following:
(2) side borders $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 561 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
(2) top/bottom borders $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Fabric G

Cut (4) squares $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Fabric H

Cut (4) squares $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
7 Brights Fromeach:
Cut (9) rectangles $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41^{1 / 2 \prime}$ (cut 10 rectangles from one fabric) to make 64 rectangles total

## Binding

Cut (7) strips $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF for binding

## Backing

Cut (2) panels $40^{\prime \prime}$ x 64 ", pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

## Notion to Sew Quilt

## Making the Quilt

1. Refer to the quilt photograph. Be sure to cut the panel so the top and bottom have the same amount of black solid, and the sides have an even amount of the print.
2. Referring to the Quilt Diagram, join the bright print rectangles into side borders of 20 patches each, and top and bottom borders of 12 patches each. Follow the diagram for color placement, or arrange the colors as you wish.
3. Sew the pieced borders to the sides of the quilt. Sew a Fabric H square to each end of remaining borders. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.
4. Sew long Fabric E borders to the sides. Join Fabric D squares to ends of shorter borders, and sew to the top and bottom.
5. Likewise, sew Fabric F borders to the sides, and Fabric F with Fabric C squares to the top and bottom. Sew Fabric B borders to the sides, and Fabric B with Fabric G squares to the top and bottom.

## Finishing the Quilt

6. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch
