# Canyon Road Quilt 

Introducing Andover Fabrics new collection: SPECTRASTATIC II by Andover Fabrics Quilt designed by Giucy Giuce

Quilt finishes 64" x 64"

> The dynamic color shifts form a pleasing mandala design in this lovely wall quilt. The light background is the perfect backdrop for your quilting.

## Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowances. A fat $1 / 8$ is a $9^{\prime \prime} x$ $20^{\prime \prime}-22^{\prime \prime}$ cut of fabric. A fat $1 / 4$ is an $18^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}-22^{\prime \prime}$ cut. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42 " wide).

9248 E4 Cut (4) squares $5^{\prime \prime}\left(47 / s^{\prime \prime}\right)$ for HST (read Step 1 before cutting)

9248 L2 Cut (4) squares $16^{1 / 2 \prime \prime} \times 16^{1 / 2 \prime}$
Cut (64) squares $5^{\prime \prime}\left(4^{7} / \mathrm{s}^{\prime \prime}\right)$
Cut (56) squares $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41^{\prime \prime}{ }^{\prime \prime}$
9248 B1 Cut (12) squares $5^{\prime \prime}\left(47 / s^{\prime \prime}\right)$ for HST
924803 Cut (6) squares $5^{\prime \prime}\left(4^{7} / s^{\prime \prime}\right)$ for HST
9248 V Cut (10) squares $5^{\prime \prime}\left(47 / 8^{\prime \prime}\right)$ for HST
9248 G4 Cut (4) squares $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Cut (8) squares $5^{\prime \prime}\left(4^{7} / 8^{\prime \prime}\right)$ for HST
3 Fat $1 / 4 \mathrm{~s}$ From each:
Cut (8) squares $5^{\prime \prime}\left(47 / 8^{\prime \prime}\right)$ for HST
2 Fat $1 / \mathrm{ss}$ From each:
Cut (2) squares 5 " ( $47 / \mathrm{s}^{\prime \prime}$ ) for HST
Binding Cut (7) strips $2^{1 / 2 \prime} \times$ WOF for binding
Backing Cut (2) panels $36^{\prime \prime} \times{ }^{\prime} 72^{\prime \prime}$, pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

## Making the Quilt

1. The quilt is made with half-square triangles (HST) that finish 4 " square. Cutting squares 5 " allows for trimming the HST after stitching. If you wish to eliminate this trimming step, cut $47 / \mathrm{s}^{\prime \prime}$ squares for HST. Set gray and hot pink squares aside for now. Use your favorite method to make HST, or follow these directions. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of 64 white ( 9248 L 2 ) 5 " squares and 2 gray ( 9428 C 1 ) squares. Place a marked white square on a bright 5 " square, right sides together. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam on each side of the marked line; cut apart on the marked line (Diagram 1). Press open to make pieced HST. Trim the squares to $4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ if needed. Make a total of 128 HST. Make 4 more HST for the quilt's center using the gray and hot pink (9248 E3) squares.

2. Referring to the Quarter Quilt Diagram, arrange the HST, white $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares, and an olive green ( 9248 G4) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square into rows as shown. Turn the HST to match the design. Join the patches into horizontal rows to make larger units. Join the top unit with the white $161 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square to make the top half of the quarter quilt. Join the top unit to the bottom unit.
3. Make 4 quarter quilts all alike. Finally, join the quarter quilts to make the quilt, rotating each unit 90 degrees to make the design shown in the quilt photograph.

Finishing the Quilt
4. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around block patches. Quilt the background white patches as you wish. Bind to finish the quilt.
