What a fun opportunity to play with color! Follow the quilt diagram and photograph or rearrange the colored strips to echo your own design sensibilities. This is a perfect throw-size quilt for someone with little or no quilting experience, or for anyone in need of a quick project.

Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include 1/4" seam allowances. A fat 1/8 is a 9" x 20"-22" cut. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 43" wide).

Fabric A

Cut (2) borders 9 1/2" x 60 1/2", cut lengthwise

Cut (3) sashes 2 1/2" x 60 1/2"

Cut (4) rectangles 6 1/2" x 12 1/2"

Cut (4) rectangles 4 1/2" x 12 1/2"

47 Fabrics

From 42: Cut (1) rectangle 2 1/2" x 12 1/2"

From 5: Cut (2) rectangles 2 1/2" x 12 1/2"

Binding

Cut (7) strips 2 1/2" x WOF for binding

Backing

Cut (2) lengths 41" x 70", pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

Making the Quilt

1. Referring to the Quilt Diagram, arrange the 52 colored strips in 4 horizontal rows, placing a Fabric A strip between each. On rows 1 and 3, position a Fabric A 4 1/2" x 12 1/2" patch on the left end and a 6 1/2" x 12 1/2" patch on the right end. On rows 2 and 4, reverse the placement of the end patches.
2. Once you are satisfied with the color placement, join the patches to make 4 rows. Press seam allowances toward the colored strips.
3. Sew the Fabric A 2 1/2" sashes between the rows.
4. Finally, sew the borders to the top and bottom.

Finishing the Quilt

5. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around borders and patches, or quilt an overall pattern. Bind to finish the quilt.
