


Making the Quilt

1. Block Assembly


Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.

- 2. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
- 3. Refer to Diagram 1 to arrange and press (4) assorted Template 1 triangles, (4) assorted Template 2 triangles and (1) Fabric I Center Template onto (1) 8 ½" Fabric T square.
- **4.** Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make (1) Block One square.
- 5. Repeat Steps 3-4 to make (12) Block One squares total.
- **6.** Repeat Steps 3-4 and refer to Diagrams 2-4 for fabric identification and location to make (10) Block Two squares, (9) Block Three squares and (11) Block Four squares.




Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)

- 7. Sew (6) assorted squares together to make (1) row. Repeat to make (7) rows total.
- 8. Sew the (7) rows together to make the Center Block.
- 9. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 56 ½" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 50 ½" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.


Finishing the Quilt

- 10. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 11. Sew the (6) Fabric B binding strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 12. Bind as desired.

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
