

Quilt finishes 52" x 65"

Everybody's favorite caterpillar sits atop colorful building blocks, surrounded by fun borders easy enough for a beginning quilter. The quilt is just the right size for snuggling under.

Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include ¼" seam allowances. A fat ¼ is a 9" x 20"-22" cut of fabric. Fabric C border measurements include extra width for insurance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge

Fabric A

Fussy-cut (1) panel $24\frac{1}{2}$ " x $44\frac{1}{2}$ ", cut crosswise (read step 1 first)

Fabric B

Fussy-cut (3) border strips 8½" x WOF, cut crosswise and pieced to make the following:
(2) top/bottom borders 8½" x 52½" (read Step 5)

Fabric C

Cut (2) side borders 3½" x 44½", cut crosswise (read Step 2) Cut (2) top/bottom borders 3" x 28½"

Fabric D

Cut (2) borders 61/2" x 471/2", cut lengthwise

Cut 6) strips 2½" x WOF for binding

Fabric E

Cut (10) strips $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF, pieced to make the following

- (2) t/b sashes $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $52\frac{1}{2}$ "
- (4) side sashes $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $47\frac{1}{2}$ "
- (22) sashes $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ "

6 Brights

From each: Cut (4) rectangles 3½" x 4½"

Backing

Cut (2) panels $37'' \times 60''$, pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides


Making the Quilt

- 1. Fussy-cut Fabric A panel to include the rows of bright circles around the center image. Be sure to add a generous ¼" seam allowance beyond the circles. Don't be concerned if the panel is not the size listed in the Cutting Directions.
- 2. The Fabric C borders are cut wider to allow for a slightly different size center panel. If the cut Fabric A panel measures 24½" x 44½", cut Fabric C border strips 2½" x 44½" and 2" x 28½". If the panel is smaller, cut Fabric C border strips 3½" x 44½" and 3" x 28½". Sew longer Fabric C borders to the sides. Trim ends even with the center panel. Join the shorter borders to the top and bottom. Trim the quilt to 28½" x 47½" if needed.
- 3. Referring to the Quilt Diagram, arrange 12 bright rectangles in a vertical row, placing a Fabric E 4½" sash between each bright patch. Sew the rectangles and sashes together. Join a Fabric E 1½" x 47½" sash to each side of the pieced row. Sew to the side of the quilt. Repeat for the other side.
- **4.** Join Fabric D borders to sides of the quilt, noting the orientation of the heart print. Sew Fabric E $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 52 $\frac{1}{2}$ " sashes to the top and bottom of the quilt.
- **5.** Fussy-cut the 3 Fabric B strips in the same part of the print. Sew strips together to make borders the length needed, joining them at a portion of the design where a seam won't be that noticeable. Sew the Fabric B borders to the top and bottom, noting orientation of the print.

6. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around borders and block patches. Quilt around the printed motifs in the center panel and borders. Bind to finish the quilt.
