


Quilt finishes 54" x 74"

Once again, Eric Carle's beloved caterpillar makes its home on this cheerful quilt that is just the right size for a child's bed. Bright prints in bold colors surround the ravenous caterpillar from the classic children's tale. More than 37 million copies have been sold since the book's publication in 1969.

Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include 1/4" seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 43" wide).

Fabric A Fussy-cut (1) panel 24 1/2" x 42 1/2", cut crosswise (read Step 1)

Fabric B Cut (2) borders 6 1/2" x 48 1/2", cut crosswise and pieced

Fabric C Cut (2) borders 6 1/2" x 54 1/2", cut crosswise and pieced

Fabric D Cut (3) squares 7 1/4" x 7 1/4", cut in half diagonally twice to make (10) quarter-square triangles

Fabric E Cut (2) borders 4 1/2" x 54 1/2", cut crosswise and pieced

Fabric F Cut (2) borders 3 1/2" x 48 1/2", cut crosswise and pieced
Cut (2) borders 3 1/2" x 24 1/2", cut crosswise and pieced

Fabric G Cut (7) strips 2 1/2" x WOF for binding

Fabric H Cut (2) borders 3 1/2" x 54 1/2", cut crosswise and pieced

Fabric I Cut (2) borders 3 1/2" x 54 1/2", cut crosswise and pieced

Fabric J Cut (2) squares 7 1/4" x 7 1/4", cut in half diagonally twice to make (8) quarter-square triangles
Cut (2) squares 3 7/8" x 3 7/8", cut in half diagonally to make (4) half-square triangles
Cut (4) rectangles 3 1/2" x 6 1/2"

Backing Cut (2) panels 41" x 62", pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

Making the Quilt

1. Fussy-cut the caterpillar panel. Measure the panel from raw edge to raw edge. If it is smaller than the size listed, cut Fabric F borders 4" wide.
2. Referring to the Quilt Diagram, sew the shorter Fabric F borders to sides of the panel. Sew the longer borders to the top and bottom. Trim this unit to 30 1/2" x 48 1/2".
3. Sew Fabric B borders to the top and bottom.
4. Referring to Diagram 1, join 4 Fabric J and 5 Fabric D quarter-square triangles to make a pieced border. Sew a Fabric J half-square triangle to each end. Sew a Fabric J rectangle to each end. Repeat to make a second pieced border. Sew the pieced borders to the sides of the quilt.
5. Sew remaining borders to the top and bottom of the quilt in the order shown.




Finishing the Quilt


6. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around borders and triangle patches. Quilt around the printed motifs in the center panel and borders. Bind to finish the quilt.



Quilt Diagram


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
