

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Let It Snow Quilt

Introducing Andover Fabrics new collection: **THINGS ARE LOOKING UP** by Kim Schaefer Quilt designed by Kim Schaefer



Quilt finishes 36" x 56"

Enjoy the smiles this wall quilt will bring to your holidays. The jubilant snowman is surrounded by easy-as-pie patchwork made with fun yuletide prints. This would be a great beginner's quilt, or for anyone who wants a quick project to brighten the season.

Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances. A fat $\frac{1}{8}$ is a 9" x 20"-22" cut of fabric. Border measurements are cut the exact lengths required plus $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Fabric A

Fussy-cut (1) panel $22\frac{1}{2}$ " x $42\frac{1}{2}$ "

Fabric B

Cut (2) borders $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $42\frac{1}{2}$ ", cut crosswise Cut (2) borders $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $22\frac{1}{2}$ ", cut crosswise

Fabric C

Cut (3) squares 41/2"

Fabric D

Cut (3) squares 41/2"

Fabric E

Cut (4) squares 3½"

Fabric F

Cut (4) squares 4½" (Red Quilt only)

Binding

Cut (5) strips 21/2" x WOF for binding

Backing

Cut (1) panel 42" x 62"

4 Reds From each:

Cut (4) squares 41/2" (Red Quilt only)

5 Blues From each:

Cut (4) squares 4½" (Blue Quilt only)

4 Greens From each:

Cut (4) squares 4½" (either quilt)


Making the Quilt

- **1.** When cutting the Fabric A panel, be sure to center the snowman so the prints are even on all sides of the panel.
- 2. Referring to the Quilt Diagram, sew long Fabric B borders to the sides of the panel. Join Fabric E 3½" squares to ends of short borders. Sew pieced borders to the top and bottom.
- 3. Refer to the quilt photograph or use your own design sensibilities to arrange 12 of the 4½" squares to make each side border. Position 9 squares for the top border and 9 for the bottom border. Stand back to be sure you like the placement and to be certain that directional prints are upright. Once you are satisfied with the arrangement, join the patches to make the borders. Sew long borders to the sides and short borders to top and bottom.

Finishing the Quilt

4. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around border patches. Quilt around the printed motifs in the panel and in the border patches. Bind to finish the quilt.






Quilt Diagram

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
