

Quilt finishes 36" x 48"

The very hungry caterpillar is hiding among the hearts and flowers in this easy-as-pie naptime quilt. The lucky child who receives the quilt will enjoy hunting for the favorite Eric Carle critter.

Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Border measurements are cut extra long for insurance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Fabric A

Fussy-cut (2) borders 31/2" x 50"

Fabric B

Cut (4) rectangles $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 17", cut lengthwise (Read Step 1.)

Cut (4) rectangles 3½" x 17", cut crosswise

Fabric C

Cut (1) strip $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x 50", cut lengthwise

Fabric D

Cut (3) strips 11/2" x WOF, pieced to make the following:

- (2) borders $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 50"
- (2) borders $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 50"

Fabric E

Cut (3) strips $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF, pieced to make the following:

(2) borders $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 50"

Cut (4) rectangles 3½" x 5½"

Fat ½s From each:

Cut (4) rectangles $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ "

Binding

Cut (5) strips 2½" x WOF for binding

Backing

Cut (1) panel 42" x 54", pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

Making the Quilt

- 1. Cut the 4 Fabric B lengthwise strips first. Cut the 4 crosswise strips from the leftover fabric. Lay out the 4 lengthwise strips end to end. Where they are to be joined, cut the ends at a 45-degree angle, following the printed stripe. Join the strips to make the left side border. Repeat these steps with the 4 crosswise strips to make the right side border.
- 2. Join the 3½" x 5½" rectangles edge to edge to make 2 vertical columns. Refer to the Quilt Diagram for color placement, or arrange them as you wish.
- **3.** Referring to the Quilt Diagram, sew the borders in the order shown to sides of the Fabric C strip. Be sure that the 2 pieced columns line up with each other. Trim the borders and center strip even with the top and bottom of the pieced columns.

Finishing the Quilt

4. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around borders and rectangles. Quilt around the printed motifs in the borders. Bind to finish the quilt.
