Quilt finishes 60" x 72"

Stars made with simple half-square triangles result in this graphic quilt that relies on light and dark contrast for impact. This is a perfect size to snuggle under, and because of the easy-peasy piecing, you will be finished in no time at all.

## Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowances. A fat $1 / 4$ is an $18^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}-22^{\prime \prime}$ cut. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge (approximately $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide).

## Cutting for ONE BLOCK

Fabric 1 (background):
Cut (4) corner squares $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Cut (4) squares 4 " for HST

## Fabric 2:

Cut (4) squares $4^{\prime \prime}$ for HST

## Fabric 3:

Cut (4) squares 4" for HST

## Cutting for Quilt

Fabrics B, E, H, J, M, N From each:
Cut (20) squares $4^{\prime \prime}$ for Half-Square Triangles (HST)
Cut (20) corner squares $312^{\prime \prime}$
Fabrics A, C, D, F, G, K, L, O, P, Q From each:
Cut (20) squares $4^{\prime \prime}$ for HST

## Fabric I

Cut (40) squares $4^{\prime \prime}$ for HST

## Binding

Cut (7) strips $2^{11 / 2 "} \times$ WOF for binding

## Backing

Cut (2) lengths $42^{\prime \prime} \times 70^{\prime \prime}$, pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

## Making the Quilt

1. The blocks are made with half-square triangles (HST). Referring to the cutting for one block, and the block diagrams, select 3 fabrics for each block. We suggest that you cut patches for one block at a time to keep the HST in order. Each block has 4 HST made with Fabrics 1 and 2, 4 HST made with Fabrics 1 and 3, and 4 HST made with fabrics 2 and 3 . Note that each pair of 4 " squares results in 2 HST.
2. The HST finish $3^{\prime \prime}$. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the lightest $4^{\prime \prime}$ square of a pair from Step 1. With right sides together, position the marked square on top of the second $4^{\prime \prime}$ square. Stitch $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on each side of the diagonal line (Diagram 1). Cut apart on the drawn line. Press the seam allowance toward the darker fabric. Trim the HST to $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. This results in 2 HST.

## Star Flower Quilt

Make 4 of each color combination for this block (12 HST total). Referring to the Block Piecing diagram, arrange the HST and the $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ corner squares in 4 rows. Stand back to be certain that the HST are rotated correctly. Once you are satisfied, join the HST and squares into rows, and then join the rows.
3. Make 5 blocks of Blocks, 2,4 , and 6 . Make 4 blocks and 2 half blocks of Blocks 1,3 , and 5 . To make the half blocks, do not join the 2 halves of the fifth block.
4. Referring to the Quilt Assembly, arrange and join the blocks and half blocks in 6 horizontal rows. Finally, join the rows.

## Finishing the Quilt

5. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around patches. Bind to finish the quilt.
