#### **Cutting Directions**

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus 1/4" seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

#### Jelly Bean - Making the Quilt

**1.** Sew (1) 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric B1 strip to each end of the 4 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric A1 strip. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 16 ½" Fabric B1 strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric A strip to make Unit 1 (Diagram 1).



- 2. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
- **3.** Press each template onto the wrong side of the wool fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
- **4.** Refer to the Jelly Bean Quilt Layout to arrange and press the assorted components onto the quilt top (Diagram 2).

#### Jelly Bean Layout



## Jelly Bean - Finishing the Quilt

- **6.** Layer and quilt as desired.
- 7. Sew the (2) Fabric B1 binding strips together, end to end with a 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 8. Bind as desired.

## **Jewels - Making the Quilt**

**9.** Sew (1) 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric B2 strip to each end of the 4 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric A2 strip. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 16 ½" Fabric B2 strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric A2 strip to make Unit 2 (Diagram 3).



- **10.** Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
- **11.** Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
- **12.** Refer to the Jewel Quilt Layout to arrange and press the assorted components onto the quilt top (Diagram 4).



## Jewel - Finishing the Quilt

- 14. Layer and quilt as desired.
- **15.** Sew the (2) Fabric B2 binding strips together, end to end with a 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 16. Bind as desired.

#### **Neutral - Making the Quilt**

**17.** Sew (1) 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric B3 strip to each end of the 4 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric A3 strip. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 16 ½" Fabric B3 strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric A3 strip to make Unit 3 (Diagram 5).



- **18.** Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
- **19.** Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
- **20.** Refer to the Neutral Quilt Layout to arrange and press the assorted components onto the quilt top (Diagram 6).

**Neutral Layout** 



#### **Neutral - Finishing the Quilt**

- 22. Layer and quilt as desired.
- **23.** Sew the (2) Fabric B3 binding strips together, end to end with a 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 24. Bind as desired.

## Stars and Stripes - Making the Quilt

- **25.** Sew together (2) 2 ½" Fabric A4 squares to make one side border. Repeat to make a second side border. Sew together (8) 2 ½" Fabric A4 squares to make the top border. Repeat to make the bottom border.
- **26.** Sew the sewn side borders to each side of the  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A4 strip. Sew the sewn top and bottom borders to the top and bottom of the Fabric A4 strip (Diagram 7).



- 27. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
- **28.** Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.

**29.** Refer to the Stars and Stripes Quilt Layout to arrange and press the assorted components onto the quilt top (Diagram 8).







## Stars and Stripes - Finishing the Quilt

- **31.** Layer and quilt as desired.
- **32.** Sew the (2) Fabric B4 binding strips together, end to end with a 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- **33.** Bind as desired.




Templates Reversed Use Jewel Wool Pack for Applique








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
