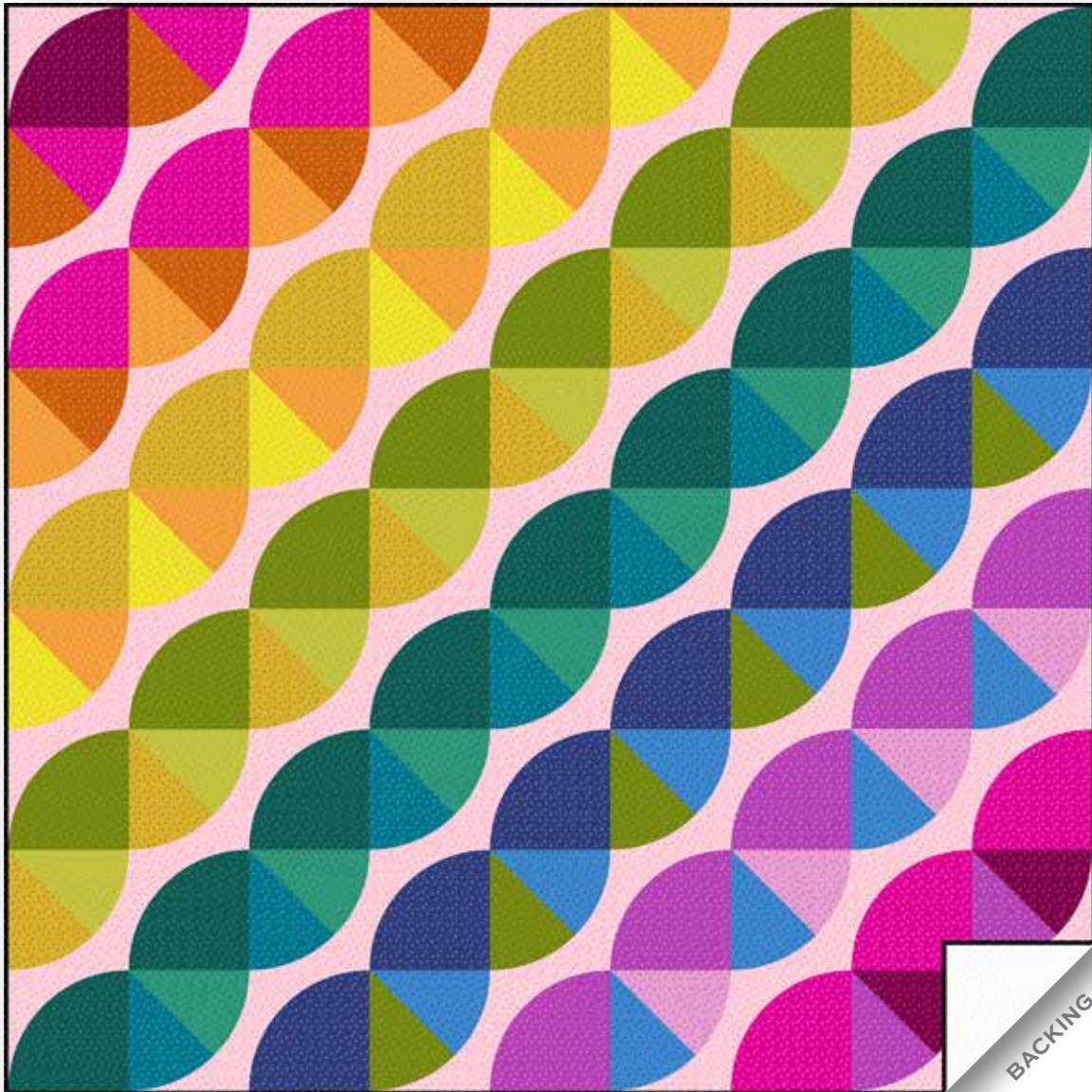

Party Town Quilt

Introducing Andover Fabrics new collection: **ATOMIC** by Libs Elliott. Quilt designed by Libs Elliott

Quilt finishes 63" x 63"
81 Blocks: 7" x 7"

Celebrate with this design that flows across the quilt's surface. An unusual palette and original blocks make this quilt fresh and fun. The curves are gentle enough to make it easy for anyone with some sewing experience.

Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches.

All measurements are cut sizes and include ¼" seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Fabric A Cut (1) square 8" for HST
(Read Step 3 before cutting)
Cut (1) Template 2

Fabric B Cut (1) square 8" for HST
Cut (6) T2

Fabric C Cut (81) T1

Fabric D Cut (3) squares 8" for HST
Cut (1) T2

Fabric E Cut (5) squares 8" for HST

Fabric F Cut (4) squares 8" for HST
Cut (5) T2

Fabric G Cut (3) squares 8" for HST

Fabric H Cut (4) squares 8" for HST

Fabric I Cut (3) squares 8" for HST
Cut (7) T2

Fabric J Cut (4) squares 8" for HST

Fabric K Cut (9) T2

Fabric L Cut (4) squares 8" for HST

Fabric M Cut (5) squares 8" for HST

Fabric N Cut (7) T2

Fabric O Cut (1) square 8" for HST
Cut (5) T2

Fabric P Cut (2) squares 8" for HST

Binding

Cut (7) strips 2½" x WOF for binding

Backing

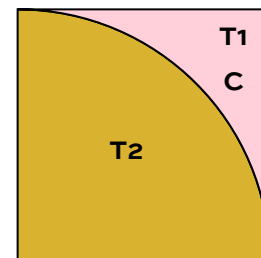
Cut (2) lengths 37" x 73", pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

Making the Quilt

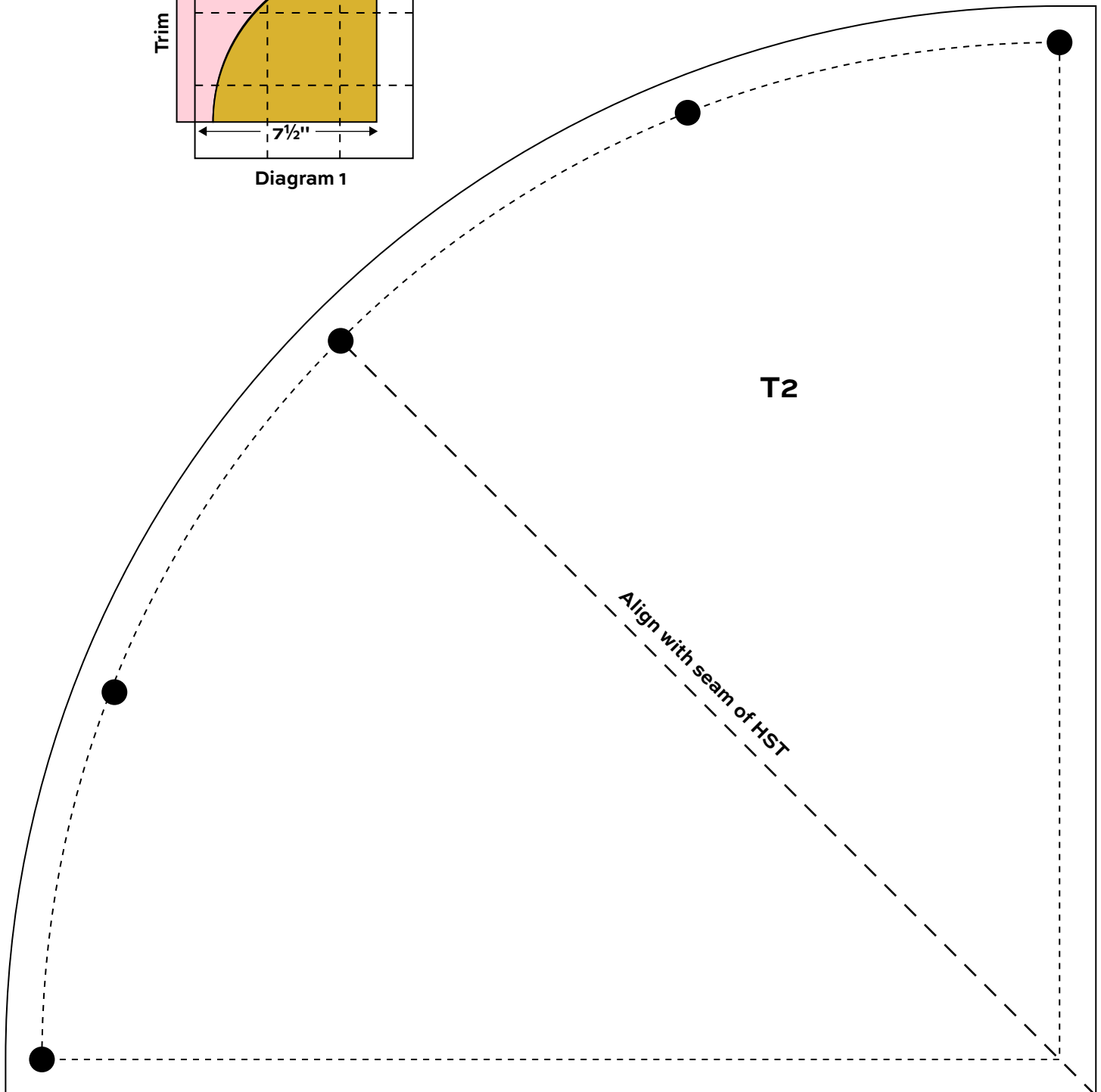
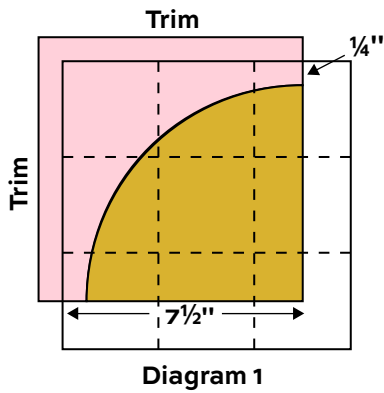
1. The Y and Z Blocks are slightly oversized to be trimmed later. Make acrylic templates of T1 and T2, including the dots and the dashed line. Poke holes with an ice pick through the template at each dot. Mark a Template 1 on the wrong side of Fabric C and a Template 2 on the wrong side of Fabric A. Mark the dots on the fabric patches. Cut the patches out. Pin the T1 patch on top of the T2, matching dots and ends. Pin along the curve at the dots and in between. Stitch in a ¼" seam allowance. Press seam allowances toward the T2 patch. Repeat these steps to make 41 Block Y with the fabric patches listed above as "T2".

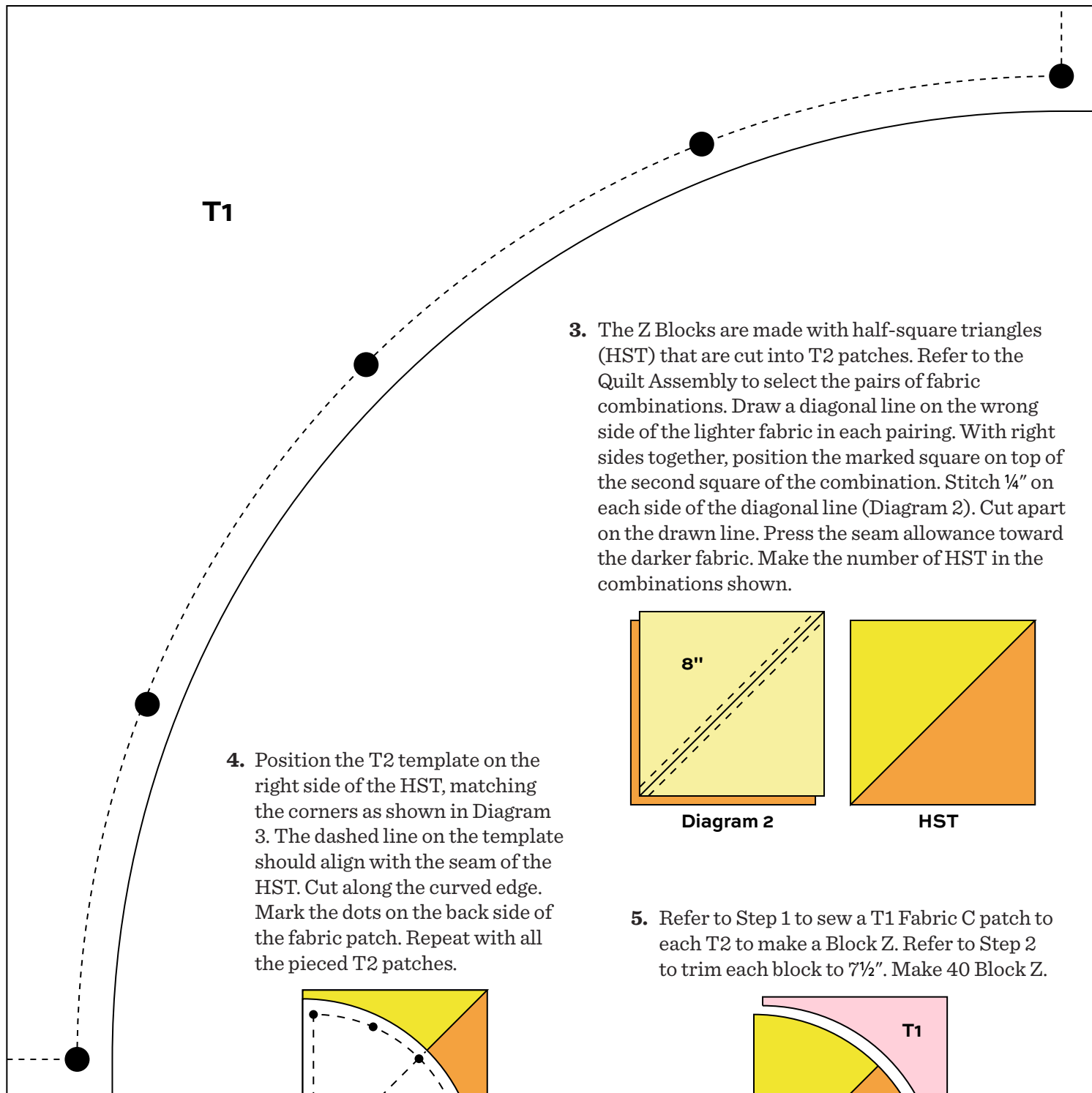


Block Y – Make 41

2. Refer to Diagram 1. Trim each block to $7\frac{1}{2}$ " as follows: Position the $7\frac{1}{2}$ " mark of the acrylic ruler on the corner of a T2 patch as shown in Diagram 1. Trim the T1 patch along the 2 opposite sides. Be sure that a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance remains beyond the T1/T2 curved seam.





T1

- The Z Blocks are made with half-square triangles (HST) that are cut into T2 patches. Refer to the Quilt Assembly to select the pairs of fabric combinations. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the lighter fabric in each pairing. With right sides together, position the marked square on top of the second square of the combination. Stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the diagonal line (Diagram 2). Cut apart on the drawn line. Press the seam allowance toward the darker fabric. Make the number of HST in the combinations shown.

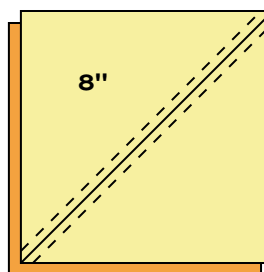
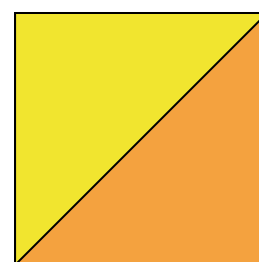

HST

- Position the T2 template on the right side of the HST, matching the corners as shown in Diagram 3. The dashed line on the template should align with the seam of the HST. Cut along the curved edge. Mark the dots on the back side of the fabric patch. Repeat with all the pieced T2 patches.

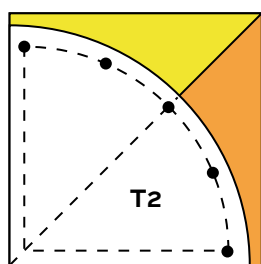
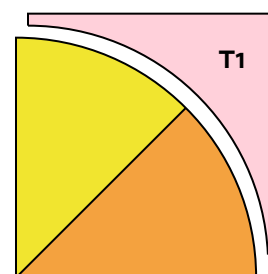

- Refer to Step 1 to sew a T1 Fabric C patch to each T2 to make a Block Z. Refer to Step 2 to trim each block to $7\frac{1}{2}$ ". Make 40 Block Z.



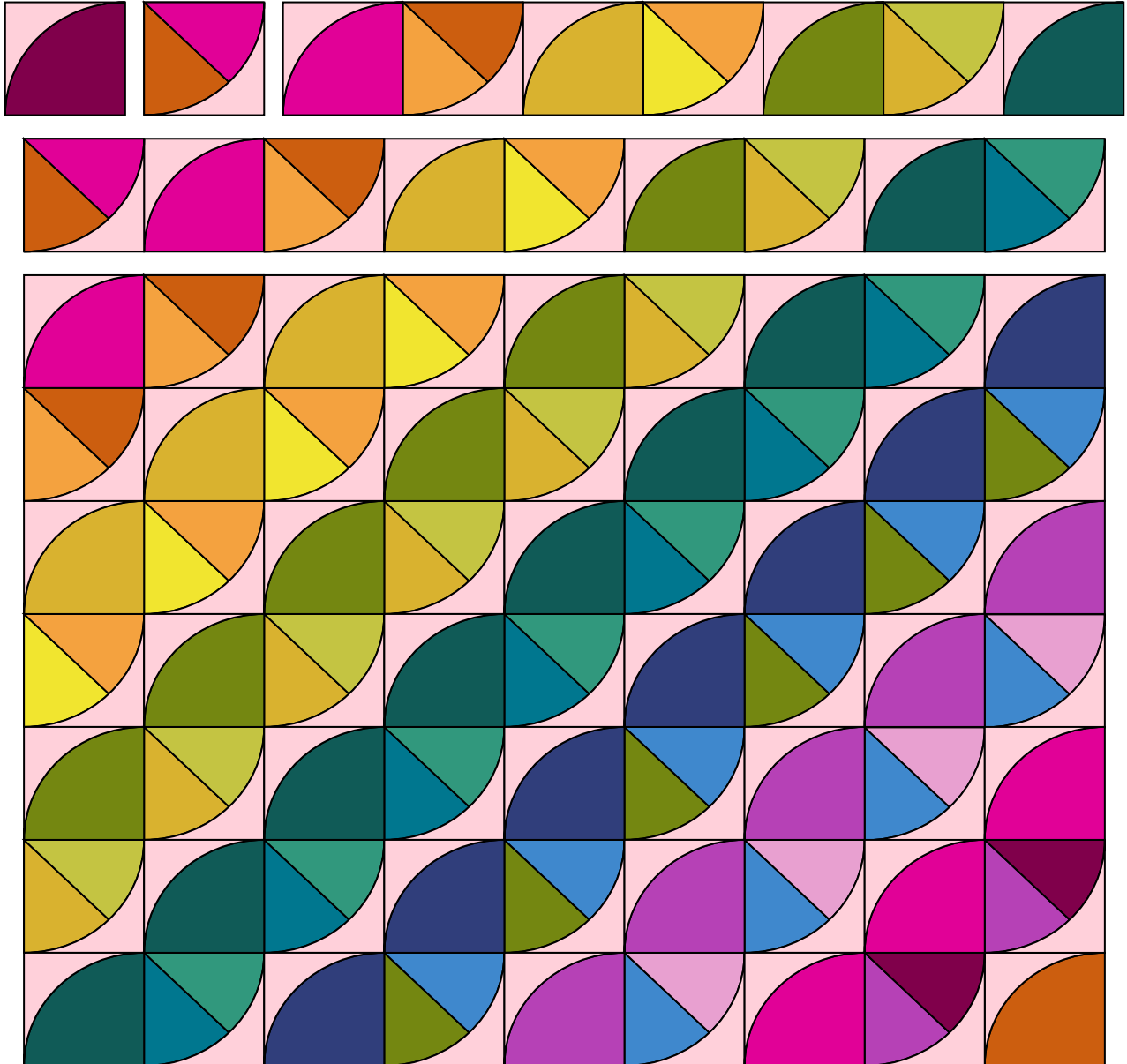
Block Z - Make 40

Party Town Quilt

- Referring to the Quilt Assembly, arrange the blocks alternately into 9 rows of 9 blocks each.
Note that odd-numbered rows begin with Block Y and even-numbered rows begin with Block Z.

Finishing the Quilt

- Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around patches. Quilt inside the T1 and T2 patches as you wish. Or, quilt an overall pattern. Bind to finish the quilt.

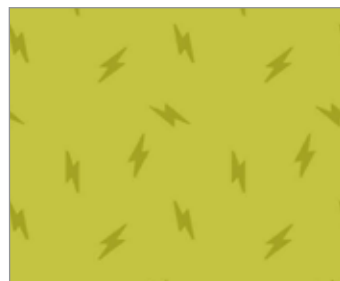

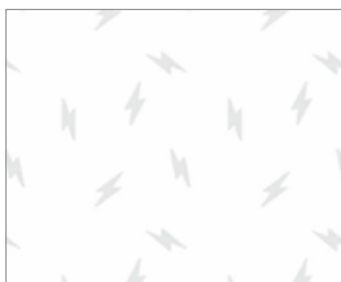

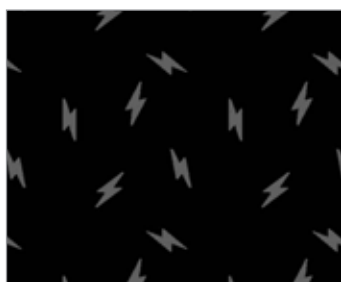
