

Dancing Eggs

- 2. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
- **3.** Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
- 4. Refer to the quilt photo to arrange and press (12) assorted egg halves (2 of the same fabric for each egg) onto one LJL strip. Place (1) egg half on (1) side of the Fabric J strip and the other half on the opposite side of the Fabric J strip to make (1) Column One (Diagram 2).
- **5.** Repeat to make Columns Two, Three and Four (Diagrams 3-5).



6. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to complete the four columns.


Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)


7. Sew (5) 1 ½ x 62 ¾ Fabric K strips and the four columns together lengthwise and alternating them, to make the quilt top.

Finishing the Quilt

- 8. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 9. Sew the (6) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric F strips together, end to end with a 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 10. Bind as desired.




Quilt Layout
