## Quilt finishes 60' x 75'

How many triangles does it take to make a stunning, graphic design? Just enough to make this great quilt to snuggle under. Once you have joined a few patches, you might be able to "eyeball" the construction to make the stitching quicker and easier.

## Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowances. A fat $1 / 4$ is an $18^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}-22^{\prime \prime}$ cut. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge (approximately $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide).

Fabric A For 4 rows
Cut (80) T2
Cut (80) T3
Fabric B For 6 rows
Cut (120) T2
Cut (120) T3
Fabric C For 4 rows
Cut (80) T2
Cut (80) T3
Fabric D For 11 rows
Cut (220) T2
Cut (220) T3
4 Prints For 3 rows from each:
Cut (58) T1
Cut (2) T2
Cut (2) T3
5 Prints For 2 rows from each:
Cut (39) T1
Cut (1) T2
Cut (1) T3
3 Prints For 1 row from each: Cut (20) T1

## Binding

Cut (7) strips $2^{1 ⁄ 21} \times \mathrm{x}$ WOF for binding

## Backing

Cut (2) lengths $42^{\prime \prime} \times 68^{\prime \prime}$, pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

## Making the Quilt

1. All odd-numbered rows are made with 19 Full Blocks, 1 Half Block, and 1 Half Block Reversed. All even-numbered rows are made with 20 Full Blocks. Refer to the cutting diagrams to conserve fabric. We suggest that you work from the top down, completing each row before cutting and stitching the next one.
2. Follow the directions that come with a specialty ruler for making "V blocks", or follow these directions. Make an acrylic or cardboard template of the 3 templates. Mark the dots at the 3 corners of each template, and use an ice pick to poke a hole at each dot. Refer to the Quilt Assembly and photograph for fabrics used in Row 1. Draw (19) T1, (1) T2, and (1) T3 on the back side of the colored turquoise fabric, marking the corner dots on the fabric. Cut the patches. Cut and mark (20) T2 and (20) T3 patches from Fabric B.

3. With right sides together and matching dots, sew a T2 triangle to the right side of a T1 patch (Diagram 1). Press seam allowance away from the T1 patch. Join a T3 patch to the opposite side (Diagram 2). Press away from the center. The block should measure $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Make 19 Full Blocks, 1 Half Block, and 1 Half Block Reversed for Row 1. Hint: Half Blocks should finish $1^{1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times} \times 1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$. Join blocks side by side to make the row.
4. Make the 20 Full Blocks needed for Row 2 . Join them side by side to make Row 2. Join Row 1 and Row 2 together.
5. Continue in this manner to make the Full Blocks and Half Blocks needed for each row. Sew the row to the bottom of the quilt as you finish it. You are less likely to get a row out of order if you follow this method. Complete the 25 rows.

## Finishing the Quilt

6. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around patches or $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ inside each triangle. Or, quilt an overall motif. Bind to finish the quilt.
