


Squares and easy half-square triangles make up these over-sized blocks that go together quickly, just in time for gifting. The placement of the high-contrast triangles add a fun diagonal element to the design.

Fabric Requirements Yardage Fabric Fabric A blocks 1½ yards 9116-G Fabric B binding ½ yard 9119-R 4 Fat ¹/₄s blocks fat 1/4 vard each 9115-E 9119-E 9122-G 9122-T 3 Teals blocks fat 1/4 yard each 9115-T 9119-T 9120-T 3 Pinks blocks fat 1/4 yard each 9117-E 9118-E 9122-E 3 Lights blocks ½ vard 9117-L 9120-L 9121-L

Cutting Directions

Backing

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances. A fat $\frac{1}{4}$ is an 18" x 20"-22" cut. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

5 vards

Fabric A

Cut (96) squares $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ "

Fabric B

Cut (8) strips 21/2" x WOF for binding

4 Fat 1/4s From each:

Cut (6) squares 5" x 5" (24 total) for half-square triangles

3 Teals From each:

Cut (12) squares $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " (36 total)

3 Pinks From each:

Cut (12) squares $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " (36 total)

3 Lights From each:

Cut (36) squares $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " (108 total)

Backing


Cut (2) panels $42'' \times 64''$, pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

Making the Quilt

1. The blocks use half-square triangles (HST) that finish 4" square. Use your favorite method to make HST, or follow these directions. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each pink 5" square (Diagram 1). Place a marked square on a teal square, right sides together. Sew \(\frac{1}{4}\)" seam on each side of the marked line; cut apart on the marked line. Press open to make 2 pieced HST. Trim each to \(\frac{4}{2}\)" square. Make 24 HST total.



2. Referring to the Block diagram, arrange 8 Fabric A 4½" squares, 9 light squares, 3 teal squares, 3 pink squares, and 2 HST into 5 rows in the order shown. Be sure to turn the HST correctly. Press the seam allowances between patches in the direction of the arrows on the diagram. Join the rows. Make 12 blocks.



3. Referring to the Quilt Diagram, join blocks in 4 rows of 3 blocks each, paying attention to the orientation of the HST. Press the seam allowances in alternating rows in opposite directions. Join the rows. Press the seam allowances in one direction or open.

Finishing the Quilt

4. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around the block patches. Quilt ½" away from the seams of the squares and triangles, or quilt them as you wish. Bind to finish the quilt.




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All fabrics are used in quilt pattern. Fabrics shown are 25% of actual size.



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
