

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Living Room Quilt



Introducing Andover Fabrics new collection: **HOME** by Sarah Golden Quilt designed by Giucy Giuce

Quilt finishes 60" x 60" 10 Block Y: 6" x 6" 45 Block Z: 6" x 6"

Choose between two very distinct color ways to make this wall quilt/throw that is sure to go together easily. The fabric prints are appealing in any combination. Feel free to make the quilt as shown or alter the blocks to make this quilt uniquely yours.

Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances. A fat $\frac{1}{4}$ is an 18" x 20"-22" cut. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Fabric A

Cut (5) strips 6½" x 30½", cut crosswise Cut (2 strips 6½" x 24½", cut crosswise Cut (2) strips 6½" x 18½", cut crosswise Cut (2) strips 6½" x 12½", cut crosswise Cut (2) squares 6½" x 6½" Cut (5) squares 7" x 7", cut in half diagonally to make10 half-square triangles

Fabric B

Cut (7) strips 2½" x WOF for binding Blue Quilt: Cut (4) squares 7" x 7", cut in half diagonally to make 8 half-square triangles Cream Quilt: Cut (5) squares 7" x 7", cut in half diagonally to make 10 half-square triangles

4 Lights

From each:

Cut (4-7) squares 7" x 7" (23 total squares), cut in half diagonally to make 46 half-square triangles (need 45)

9 Mediums From each:

Blue Quilt: Cut (2-4) squares 7" x 7" (24 total squares), cut in half diagonally to make 48 half-square triangles (need 47)

Cream Quilt: Cut (2-4) squares 7" x 7" (23 total squares), cut in half diagonally to make 46 half-square triangles (need 45)

Backing

Cut (2) panels 34" x 68", pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides


Making the Quilt


- 1. Referring to the Block Y diagram, join a Medium triangle with a Fabric A triangle to make a square. Press the seam allowances to one side. Trim the square to 61/2" if needed. Make 10 Block Y.
- 2. Referring to the Block Z diagram, join a Medium triangle or a Fabric B triangle with a light triangle. Follow Step 1 to make 45 Block Z, using various combinations of light and medium prints as you desire.
- **3.** Arrange the Fabric A strips and blocks into 10 rows as shown in the Quilt Diagram. Be sure to rotate the blocks as shown. Join the strips and blocks into rows. Join the rows.

Finishing the Quilt

4. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt around the strips and block patches. Or, quilt an overall design as you wish. Bind to finish the quilt.
