

Table Runner finishes 28" x 66" Wall Quilt finishes 28" x 38" Placemat finishes 12" x 18"

These delightful projects will brighten up the holiday with pretty pastel prints that include peeps, bunnies, jelly beans, and a rickrack stripe. The wall quilt is just the size to hang in a dining room, and the table runner and placemats will add to your table décor. They are so quick and easy that you may choose to make all of them.

Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include ½" seam allowances. A fat ½ is a 9" x 20"-22" cut of fabric. Borders are cut the exact lengths required plus ½" seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 43" wide).

Table Runner

14 Prints From each: Cut (2) squares $5\frac{1}{2}$ " (28 total)

5 Prints From each: Cut (1) egg

Blue Stripe Cut (2) rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ "

Multi Stripe Cut (6) strips 3½" x WOF, pieced to

make the following: (2) borders 3½" x 60½" (2) borders 3½" x 22½"

White Prt. Cut (2) rectangles $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x $24\frac{1}{2}$ "

Pink Cut (4) squares $3\frac{1}{2}$ " for outer

border corners

Yellow Cut (4) strips 1½" x WOF, pieced to

make the following: 2 borders 1½" x 48½" 2 borders 1½" x 12½"

Binding

Cut (5) strips 2½" x WOF for binding

Backing

Cut (2) lengths $38" \times 38"$, pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

Egg Roll Projects

Wall Quilt

20 Prints From each: Cut (1) rectangle $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ "

Multi Stripe Cut (2) borders 1½" x 36½"

Cut (2) borders 11/2" x 281/2"

White Prt. Cut (2) rectangles $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x $28\frac{1}{2}$ "

Teal Cut the words

Black Cut bunny eyes, mouth, whiskers

Pink Cut bunny inner ears and nose

White Cut bunny head, outer ears

Orange Cut (4) squares $3\frac{1}{2}$ " for border corners

Yellow Cut (2) borders $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $28\frac{1}{2}$ "

Cut (2) borders 11/2" x 201/2"

Binding

Cut (4) strips 21/2" x WOF for binding

Backing

Cut (1) length 38" x 48"

4 Placemats

16 Prints From each: Cut (2) squares 5½"

(8 squares for each mat)

From 3 of the prints, cut 1 egg

Grn. Stripe Cut (1) egg

White Prt. Cut (1) rectangle $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " for each mat

Yellow Cut (2) rectangles $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " for each mat

Binding

Cut (2) strips 21/2" x WOF for binding for each mat

Backing

Cut (1) length 18" x 24" for each mat

Making the Table Runner

- 1. Prepare the eggs for fusible appliqué.
 Press the 5 eggs to the White Print
 rectangle, referring to the Quilt Diagram for
 placement. Finish the edges with contrasting
 thread and a machine zigzag stitch, or use
 invisible thread around the edges.
- **2.** Sew long Yellow borders to the sides of the panel. Sew short borders to the top and bottom.
- 3. Referring to the Quilt Diagram, arrange the 5½" squares around the panel. Add the Blue Stripe rectangles at the center of the top and bottom borders. Join 10 squares for each side border, and sew to the quilt. Join squares and Blue Stripe rectangles to make the top and bottom borders. Sew to the quilt.
- **4.** Sew long Multi Stripe borders to the sides. Join Pink squares to the ends of short borders and sew to the top and bottom.

Finishing the Table Runner

5. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around borders, patches, and eggs, or quilt an overall design. Bind to finish the quilt.

Making the Wall Quilt

- 1. Refer to Step 1 for the Table Runner to appliqué the words and bunny to the White Print rectangle. Hint: You may prefer to embroider the whiskers or use black rickrack for them.
- **2.** Sew long Yellow borders to the sides of the panel. Sew short borders to the top and bottom.
- 3. Referring to the Quilt Diagram, arrange the 3½" x 5½" rectangles around the panel. Join 6 rectangles for each side border, and sew to the quilt. Join 4 rectangles and orange squares to make the top and bottom borders. Sew to the quilt.
- **4.** Sew long Multi Stripe borders to the sides. Sew short borders to the top and bottom.

Finishing the Wall Quilt

5. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around borders, patches, and the applique, or quilt an overall design. Bind to finish the quilt.


Making 1 Placemat

- **1.** Refer to Step 1 for the Table Runner to appliqué the egg to the White Print rectangle.
- 2. Sew Yellow borders to the sides of the panel.
- **3.** Referring to the Quilt Diagram, arrange the $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares on the sides of the panel. Join the squares and sew them to the quilt.

Finishing the Placemat


4. Layer the mat with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around borders, patches, and the appliqué, or quilt an overall design. Bind to finish the quilt.







Quilt Diagrams













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All fabrics are used in quilt pattern. Fabrics shown are 25% of actual size.



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
