Fabric Requirements

Fat 1/8 yard of each of the following fabrics (star blocks)

4267-V* border, binding 2 yds SO260-AND-BLACK sashes, blocks 3½ yds

*Additional fabric required for backing.

4267-V* backing 43/8 yds

Quilt finishes 70" x 70" 36 Pieced Blocks: 8" x 8"

Simply elegant, this wall quilt shines as though lit from within. The easy star blocks glow against the black background, and an unexpected surprise happens when the colors are reversed in three of the blocks.

Cutting Directions

Note: A fat $\frac{1}{8}$ yard is a 9" x 20"-22" cut of fabric. Borders are cut the exact lengths required plus $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances.

Fat 1/8 yard fabrics

From each of 24:

Cut (1) square 4½" for 1 colored star (24 squares total, see Step 1)

Cut (8) squares 2½" for 1 colored star (192 squares total)

From each of 3:

Cut (2) squares 4½" for 2 colored stars (6 squares total)

Cut (16) squares 2½" for 2 colored stars (48 squares total)

From each of 3:

Cut (1) square 4½" for 1 colored star (3 squares total, see Step 1)

Cut (8) squares 2½" for 1 colored star (24 squares total)

Cut (4) squares 2½" for black star background (12 total)

Cut (4) rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " for black star flying geese (12 total)

Cut (2) borders $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $70\frac{1}{2}$ ", cut lengthwise

Cut (2) borders $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $62\frac{1}{2}$ ", cut lengthwise

Cut (5) strips 21/2" x 60" for binding

SO260-AND-BLACK 3½ yds

Cut (7) long sashes 2½" x 62½"

Cut (42) short sashes 21/2" x 81/2"

Cut (132) rectangles 2½" x 4½" for flying geese units

Cut (132) squares 21/2" for block background

Cut (3) squares 4½" for black stars

Cut (24) squares 21/2" for black stars

Backing


Cut (2) panels 39" x 78", pieced to fit quilt top with 4" overlap


Making and Assembling the Quilt


- Each fat 1/8 yard fabric is used to make 1 or 2 blocks. Choose 3 of these fabrics to make 2 blocks each. In addition, choose 3 of these fabrics to use for the backgrounds of the 3 black star blocks. Cut patches as listed.
- 2. Flying Geese: Referring to Diagrams 1-4, draw a diagonal line on wrong side of colored 2½" squares, 8 for each of 33 blocks. Place marked square on the black 2½" x 4½" rectangle, right sides together, aligning raw edges. Sew on marked line; trim away and discard excess fabric. Press open. Repeat process on opposite end of rectangle to make a flying geese unit. Make 4 units for each block. Likewise, stitch 2 black squares on a colored 2½" x 4½" rectangle (Diagram 5). Make 4 flying geese units alike for each of the 3 black star blocks.
- 3. Referring to the Block Diagrams, join flying geese units and background patches to make 33 colored star blocks and 3 black star blocks.
- 4. Refer to the Quilt Diagram. Arrange the 36 stars to your liking. Join 6 stars and 7 short sashes to make a block row. Make 6 block rows. Join the block rows with the 7 long sashes.
- 5. Sew short border strips to sides. Sew long borders to top and bottom.


Finishing the Quilt

6. Layer quilt with batting and backing. Quilt in the ditch around border and block patches. Quilt a motif of your choice in the center squares in the blocks. Bind to finish the quilt.
