

Elegant floral prints add drama to this striking wall quilt. Strip piecing and a fast method to make the blocks and units will have this lovely design on your wall in no time at all.

Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include 1/4" seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).





Making the Quilt

- 1. Referring to Band 1 diagram, join 4 WOF strips in the order shown to make a pieced band. Press seam allowances in one direction. Repeat to make 3 pieced bands alike. From the bands, cut a total of (4) rectangles 16½" x 8½" and (6) squares 8½" x 8½".
- 2. Repeat Step 1 to make 3 bands from the 4 remaining WOF strips (Band 2 diagram). Cut the bands into 4 rectangles and 6 squares as listed in Step 1.





- 3. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of each Fabric B 8½" square. Referring to Diagram 1, position a marked square on top of a Band 1 square, being sure that the diagonal line is oriented on the pieced square as shown. Stitch along the marked line. Trim ¼" away from the sewing line as shown (Diagram 2). Press the floral triangle open to make Block X. Make 6.
- **4.** Repeat these steps to make 6 Block Y using Fabric B squares and squares from Band 2. Make 6.





- **5.** In the same manner, stitch a Fabric B square to one end of each of the $16\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles from Band 1 and Band 2. Trim as in Step 3. Make 4 Unit 1 and 4 Unit 2.
- **6.** Referring to the Block Z diagram, position 2 Unit 1 and 2 Unit 2 around a Fabric C square in the order shown. The numbers 1-5 on the diagram show the order in which the units are stitched to the center square. With edges even along the top, stitch a Unit 1 to the left side of the center square, stopping stitching about 2" away from the bottom edge of the square. This is the partial seam 1. Working in a clockwise direction, sew a Unit 2 along the top edge (seam 2), add a Unit 1 to the right edge (seam 3), and a Unit 2 to the bottom edge (seam 4). Finally, complete the partial seam (seam 5). Make 2 Block Z.





Unit 2 - Make 4




Block Z - Make 2

7. Referring to the Quilt Diagram, join 3 Block X and 3 Block Y to make the top row, turning blocks as shown. Sew a Fabric A square to the correct side of a Block Z for row 2. Repeat to make rows 3 and 4. Join the rows.

Finishing the Quilt

8. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around block patches. Quilt around the printed motifs in Fabric A squares. Bind to finish the quilt.
