

### **Cutting Directions**

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus ¼" seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Fabric A	Cut (2) 4 ½"x 59 ½" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips. Cut (2) 4 ½"x 52 ½" LOF strips.
Fabric B	Cut (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 57 ½" strips. Cut (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 44 ½" strips.

Fabric C	From the (7) Fat Quarters, cut a
	total of (12) $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " squares and
	(118) 3 ½" squares.

Fabric D	From the (5) Fat Quarters, cut a
	total of (12) 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares and
	(60) 3 ½" squares.

Fabric E	Cut the (4) Fat Quarters, cut a total
	of (64) $3\frac{1}{2}$ squares and (1) Star.

Binding	Cut (6) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the
	binding.

Backing	Cut (2) 60" x WOF strips. Sew the
	strips together and trim to
	make (1) 60" x 75" backing.


## **Making the Quilt**

#### 1. Block Assembly

Place (1) 3 %" Fabric D square on top of (1) 3 %" Fabric C square, right side together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Diagram 1). Sew %" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 2) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 3 %" square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Diagram 3). Repeat to make (24) 3 %" Unit 1 squares total.

#### **Trim the Tree**

2. Follow Diagram 4 and arrange the (64) 3 ½" Fabric E squares, (118) 3 ½" Fabric C squares, (60) 3 ½" Fabric D squares and (24) 3 ½" Unit 1 squares into (19) rows of (14) blocks each. Sew the (19) rows together to make the Center Block. Pay attention to the orientation of the Unit 1 squares.



#### **Quilt Top Assembly**


#### (Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)

- **3.** Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the Star template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out the template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
- **4.** Press the template onto the wrong side of the fabric as listed on the template. Cut out the template on the drawn lines.


- **5.** Refer to the quilt layout to arrange and press the Fabric E Star onto the Center Block.
- **6.** Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch.
- 7. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 57 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 44 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- **8.** Sew (1) 4 ½" x 59 ½" Fabric A strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 52 ½" Fabric A strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

### Finishing the Quilt

- 9. Layer and quilt as desired.
- **10.** Sew the (6) Binding strips together, end to end with a 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 11. Bind as desired.




Quilt Layout
