# Trim the Tree

## Quilt finished 52" x 67"

## Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42 " wide).

Fabric A
Cut (2) $41 / 2$ "x $591 / 2$ " Length of Fabric (LOF) strips. Cut (2) $41 / 2$ "x $521 / 2$ " LOF strips.

Fabric B Cut (3) $11 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut
(2) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 571 / 2$ " strips.

Cut (3) $1 / 1 / 2 \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 441 / 2 "$ strips.

Fabric C From the (7) Fat Quarters, cut a total of (12) $37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares and (118) $3^{1 / 2 "}$ " squares.

Fabric D From the (5) Fat Quarters, cut a total of (12) $37 / \mathrm{s}^{\prime \prime}$ squares and (60) $31 / 2$ " squares.

Fabric E Cut the (4) Fat Quarters, cut a total of (64) $31 / 2$ " squares and (1) Star.

Binding

Backing

Cut (6) $21 / 2$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

Cut (2) 60 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 60" x 75 " backing.

## Making the Quilt

## 1. Block Assembly

Place (1) $37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D square on top of (1) $37 / 8$ " Fabric C square, right side together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Diagram 1). Sew $1 / 4$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 2) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure $31 / 2$ " square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Diagram 3). Repeat to make (24) $31 / 2$ " Unit 1 squares total.


## Trim the Tree

2. Follow Diagram 4 and arrange the (64) $3^{1 / 2}$ " Fabric E squares, (118) $31 / 2$ " Fabric C squares, (60) $31 / 2$ " Fabric D squares and (24) $31 / 2$ " Unit 1 squares into (19) rows of (14) blocks each. Sew the (19) rows together to make the Center Block. Pay attention to the orientation of the Unit 1 squares.

## Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)
3. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the Star template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out the template about $1 / 8$ " outside the drawn lines.
4. Press the template onto the wrong side of the fabric as listed on the template. Cut out the template on the drawn lines.
5. Refer to the quilt layout to arrange and press the Fabric E Star onto the Center Block.
6. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch.
7. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1 / 2 "}{} \times 571 / 2$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 441 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
8. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 591 / 2 "$ Fabric A strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 521 / 2 "$ Fabric A strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

## Finishing the Quilt

9. Layer and quilt as desired.
10. Sew the (6) Binding strips together, end to end with a 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
11. Bind as desired.
