

Cutting Directions - Both Versions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus 1/4" seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Fabric A	Cut (1) 23" x 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle.
Fabric B	Cut (2) 2 ½" x 26 ½" WOF strips.

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Fabric F	Cut ((1)	$2\frac{1}{2}$	'x	WOF	strip.
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Fabric G	Cut (1) 2'	" x WOF	'strip.
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Fabric H	Cut (2)	2" x	WOF.	strips.
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Fabric I Cut (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip.

Fabric J Cut (2) 2" x WOF strips.

Binding Cut (5) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips.

Backing Cut (2) 45" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make

(1) 45" x 65" backing.

Making the Quilt

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Block Assembly

Sew (1) 2 1/4" x 42 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the 23" x 42 1/2" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $26\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Diagram 1).

Trim the block to measure 25 ½" x 45 ½".



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
- 2. Sew together (1) 2" x WOF Fabric H strip, (1) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric C strip and (1) 2" x WOF Fabric J strip, lengthwise and in that order from left to right, to make (1) Strip Set 1 (Diagram 2). Repeat to make a second Strip Set 1.
- Cut the Strip Set 1's into (32) 2" x 5 1/2" Unit 1 strips (Diagram 3).




4. Repeat Steps 2-3 and refer to Diagrams 4-7 for fabric identification and placement to make (16) 2" x 5 1/2" Unit 2 strips and (16) 2" x 5 ½" Unit 3 strips.




- **5.** Sew (1) 2" x WOF Fabric C strip to each side of (1) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric I strip lengthwise to make (1) Strip Set 4 (Diagram 8).
- **6.** Cut the Strip Set 4 into (16) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 4 strips (Diagram 9).



7. Repeat Steps 5-6 and refer to Diagram 10-11 for fabric identification and placement to make (16) 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" Unit 5 strips.



8. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) Unit 4 strip lengthwise to make (1) 5 1/2" Block One square (Diagram 12). Repeat to make (16) Block One squares total.



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9. Sew together (1) Unit 2 strip, (1) Unit 5 strip and (1) Unit 3 strip, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make (1) 5 ½" Block Two square (Diagram 13). Repeat to make (16) Block Two squares total.



10. Sew together (5) Block
One squares and (4) Block
Two squares, alternating
them from top to bottom,
to make the Left Side
Border (Diagram 14).
Repeat to make the Right
Side Border (Diagram 15).



11. Sew together (4) Block Two squares and (3) Block One squares, alternating them from left to right, to make the Top Border (Diagram 16). Repeat to make the Bottom Border (Diagram 17).






Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)

- **12.** Sew the Left Side Border and the Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.
- **13.** Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- **14.** Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 55 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 37 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

Finishing the Quilt

- 15. Layer and quilt as desired.
- **16.** Sew the (5) binding strips together, end to end with a 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 17. Bind as desired.
